The CVCC continues to do good work on behalf of all owners of Classic Cars, and included below are items of interest from their recent Newsletter.

- Keeping a watchful eye on the 'lead in petrol' pressure groups...as this would affect older vehicles.
- New regulations re transfer of cherished vehicle registration numbers:  
Any vehicle still in existence but not registered at DVLC will lose its claim to its original number if such vehicle is not registered prior to November 1983. Cars 'found' after this date will be given a number appropriate to their age.  
Also if you do not want to lose your old style log book when you apply, then enclose a letter requesting its return.

- Insurance Companies who appear to accommodate the problems of insuring Classic Vehicles: Dave Allen of CVCC has investigated and produced the following list. (not in any order of priority) The policies may well differ...some offering dual cover, i.e. modern car with classic attached; some stipulate 'limited mileage'; most work on agreed values.
